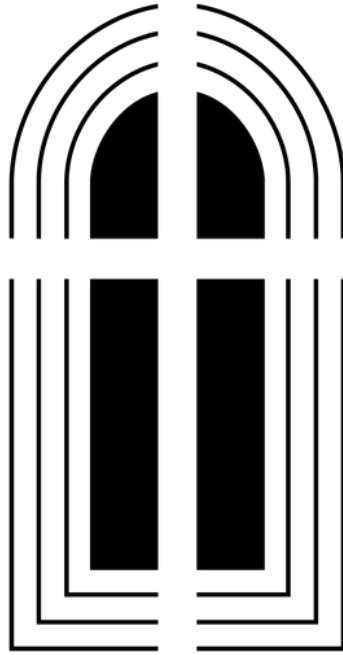

Sunday Overview

Sunday School

- 9:45am - The Gathering
 - All 6-12th graders gather together in the Stock Building 2nd floor lobby before classes begin. Games, snacks, jams. Come as you are!
- 10:00am - Class
 - 6th and 7th grade meet for Pre-Confirmation in the MS Room. This class studies the big picture of the Bible, taking 1 year to study the Old Testament and 1 year to study the New Testament.
 - 8th grade meets for Confirmation in the Confirmation Room. We ask big questions together and spend the year discerning what it is that we believe.
 - 9-12th grade meets for Coffee Shop Sunday School. We'll gather in the Stock Building, then at 10:00 we'll walk together to a downtown coffee shop to check in about our week, explore some Big Faith Questions, and see how we can support one another in prayer during the upcoming week.

 - We meet first for dinner in Memorial Hall and then move into programming in the Stock Building youth rooms. Our primary goal is to create a safe space for tweens and teens to be themselves, ask the hard questions, and always feel supported in their faith community.

Confirmation

A year of exploring, questioning, and claiming your faith.

Youth in 8th grade have the opportunity to participate in our Confirmation Class. Confirmation will meet on Sundays at 9:45am on the 2nd floor of the Stock Building beginning on September 13.

Confirmation is a time of exploring faith, asking questions, and learning what it is that the Presbyterian Church (USA) believes. At the end of Confirmation, youth will have the opportunity to join the church, though joining is not required - the goal is deep exploration of faith.

As youth engage with scripture, theology, and mission in new ways, they'll walk along this journey with mentors from the congregation, pastors, and church staff.

Summer 2027

As a part of our ministry's yearly rhythm, we attend conferences where youth and their leaders gather to worship, play, and grow together in faith. Our groups return from these trips with inside jokes, stories, and memories that last a lifetime! Conferences provide emotionally, spiritually, and physically safe spaces to think through theology, challenge our current thinking, find inspiration, and learn and grow together as a church family.

June 13 - 19, 2027

High School Service Trip

When: June 13 - 19, 2027
Who: Current 8-12th graders
Where: Appalachia (location TBD)
Cost: \$400

Appalachia Service Project is back! We'll have 3 crews working to make homes warmer, safer, and dryer. ASP has sites across NC, VA, WV, KY, and TN. As in 2025, we'll hear from ASP in late spring with our exact location. Required tools training 10am June 12.

June 23 - July 3, 2027

Worship & Music Conference

Who: Current 6-12th graders
Where: Montreat, NC
Cost: \$500

Worship & Music is an intergenerational conference in Montreat, NC for children, youth, and adults who love to sing, play, learn, and worship together. Musically inclined youth are encouraged to sign up, but musical skills are not required!

July 8-11, 2027

Massanetta Middle School Conference

When: July 8 - 11, 2027
Who: Current 5-8th graders
Where: Massanetta Springs, VA
Cost: \$350

Massanetta is a conference designed JUST for middle school brains! We'll spend 4 days at Massanetta listening to keynote speakers, doing energizers, going to worship, singing, sticking our feet in the springs, and bonding as a group.

July 18-24, 2027

Montreat Youth Conference

When: July 18 - 24, 2027
Who: Current 8-12th graders
Where: Montreat, NC
Cost: \$500

We'll spend a week in the mountains worshipping, reflecting, laughing, playing, praying, and growing in our relationships with each other and God. We'll stay in a house and prepare meals together. We hope you'll join us!



2027 Registration Process

Registration for all summer trips will happen on Realm with a \$200 deposit required at registration. Registering EARLY helps us to make more accurate early-bird group holds for FPC, locking in less expensive rates for our group, being good stewards of your family's and the church's budget.

Final payments for all summer trips are due Monday, March 1.

Fall Registration Period

OCTOBER 1, 2026 to NOVEMBER 1, 2026

Worship and Music & Massanetta: This is not first-come, first-served. All who register online and pay a \$200 non-refundable deposit between these dates will have a guaranteed spot on summer trips.

ASP & Montreat: The number of spots available for ASP and Montreat is limited by transportation and housing. Spots are first-come, first-served.

Winter Registration Period

JANUARY 4, 2026 to MARCH 1, 2026

There is no guarantee that trips will have spaces available during this registration period. If needed, we will move to a waitlist. Adults will be invited to participate as summer trip leaders during this time.

Open Registration Period

MARCH 1 until TRIPS FILL or 30 DAYS BEFORE TRIP DEPARTURE

We will do our best to register you for trips after March 1, but cannot guarantee your space. To confirm space availability, all of your paperwork and deposit must be completed and turned in. We may only be able to accept registrations after March 1 if there is a cancellation by another registered participant.

Youth Trip Refund Policy

Because trip reservations and payments are made in advance based on participant registrations, refunds can only be provided under the conditions outlined below:

Before March 1: A refund of payments made beyond the \$200 deposit will only be issued if another participant is able to take the canceled spot. If there is no waitlist, the cancelling family is responsible for finding a replacement.

After March 1: No refunds will be issued, as trip balances and commitments will already have been paid.

We are blessed with a healthy church budget. That means:
